4. What is your opinion regarding CDC 's policies, practices and recommendations for handwashing and respiratory etiquette in regards to our school?

5. What is your opinion regarding CDC 's policies, practices and recommendations for cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including ventilation in regards to BPLA?

6. What is your opinion regarding CDC 's policies, practices and recommendations for contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine in regards to our students and staff?

7. What is your opinion regarding recommendations for statewide testing during a pandemic?

8. What is your opinion regarding CDC 's policies, practices and recommendations for efforts to provide vaccinations to educators, other staff, and students if eligible?
